WORK: Teachers are not required to work.

ACCOMPANIST: Accompanists should be arranged by the teacher, as well as rehearsals/
compensation.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Students may enter one (memorized) short piece or single movement of at least 16 measures in length by a composer from any genre.
2. Acceptable pieces DO NOT include selections from method books, easy-play transcriptions, or arrangements.
3. Students must bring their own published music for the judge.
PHOTOCOPIES WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.
4. Measures should be numbered.

PERFORMANCE PROCEDURE:

- One judge will hear each student and will give an evaluation.
- Ratings are Superior Plus, Superior, and Excellent.
- Students earning a Superior Plus rating will receive a trophy.
- Students earning a Superior rating will receive a ribbon.
- All students will receive certificates.

In addition to street parking, free parking is also available in parking structure P (on Garden Avenue). Enter in the front doors of the Music Building and check in with the info desk (located in the Recital Hall, immediately past the front doors). Students can then meet with their accompanist in a practice room before playing for the judge. Students will perform for the judge in a separate area, and are free to go home after playing. Your teacher will contact you with your child's rating after Monday, October 16.

Some important notes:

- The warmup room is located in the basement (just down the hall from the waiting area)
- The bathroom is located under the stairs going to the 2nd floor.
- This is a closed festival, meaning only the student, accompanist, and judge will be in the performance area.
- Students should dress as if playing in a recital.
- Don't forget the music!

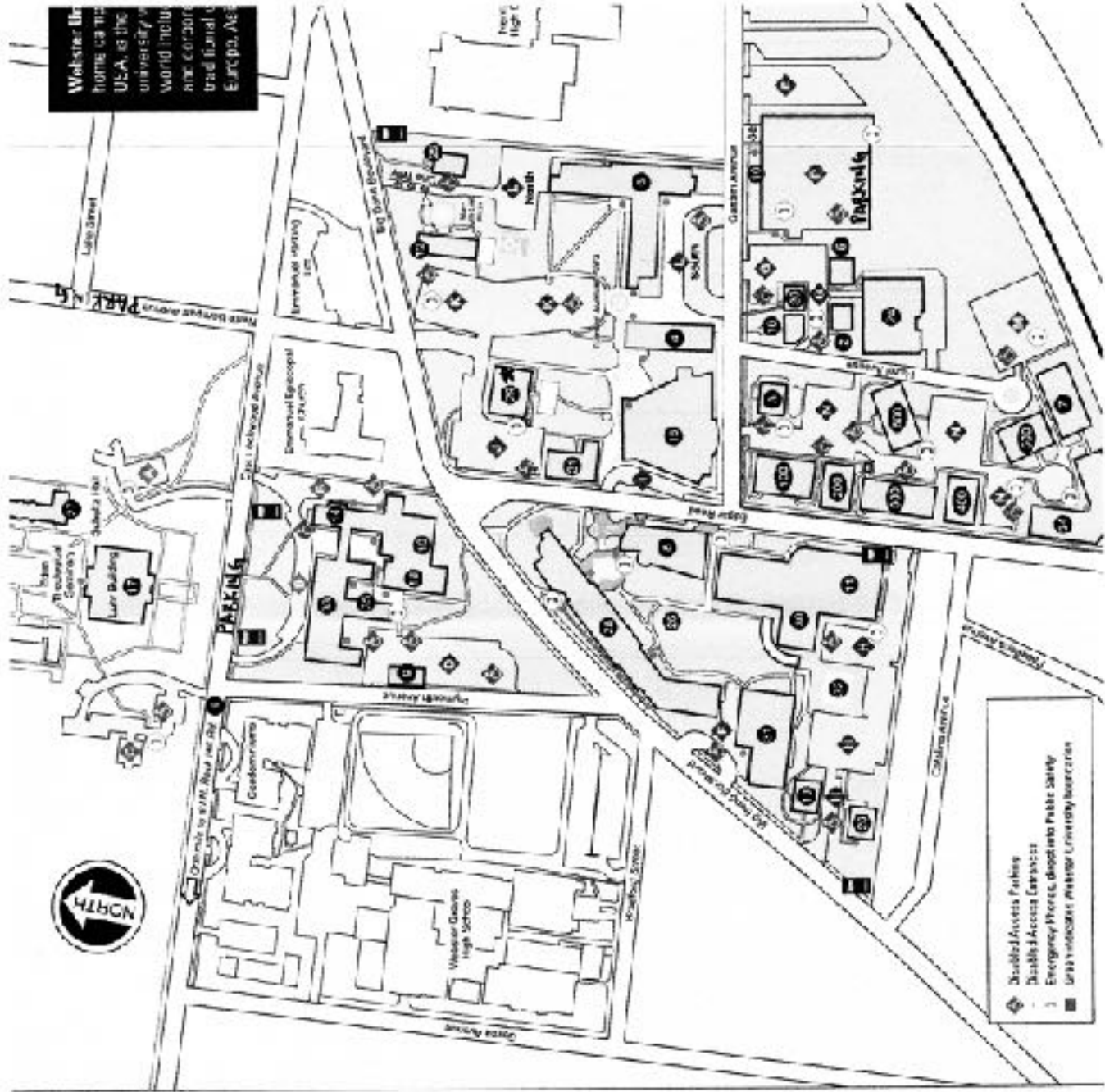
