WORK: Teachers are not required to work.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Students may enter two short pieces or single movements of at least 16 measures in length by a composer from any genre (duets may use the music)
2. Acceptable pieces DO NOT include selections from lesson books, easy-play transcriptions, or arrangements.
3. Students must bring their own published music for the judge.
Photocopies may only be used to aid in page turns.
4. Two copies of each duet will be needed (one for the performers and one for the judge)
5. Measures should be numbered (beginning of each line is fine)

PERFORMANCE PROCEDURE:

- One judge will hear each student and will give an evaluation.
- Ratings are Superior Plus, Superior, and Excellent.
- Students earning a Superior Plus rating will receive a trophy.
- Students earning a Superior rating will receive a ribbon.
- All students will receive certificates.
